Official rules for participants

Science Me! is open to all sciences. Each of the participating teams (1-2 scientists per team) will give a single show of 10min, in English or French. Teams —anonymous during their show— will be evaluated by the public (applause-meter) and by a jury of specialists in science communication. The jury will assess pedagogical and artistic input of shows and their scientific relevance, the interactivity with the public, the clarity of the concepts presented, and the respect of safety regulations. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams during a closing ceremony on July 10, 17h.

Conditions of participation

A maximum of 12-15 teams will be invited to the competition after review of their application. Participation is free-of-charge, including lodging. Upon motivated request, the organisers will provide financial support for travel expenses and/or for specific facilities.
